is a former professional football player who originates from East St. Louis, Illinois. While traversing through multiple leagues throughout his career, during his downtime, he found himself working with the NAACP and speaking on several panels concerning issues of social inequity and injustice. After suffering a career-ending leg injury, Dr. Anderson decided to bolster his diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) knowledge by earning a 4.0 GPA in his Masters of Sociology from Arizona State University – he went on to become a professor of sociology and a manager of diversity, equity, and inclusion. He is also a proud member of the American Sociological Association.

Having experienced, witnessed, and researched the social inequalities that have detrimentally impacted African American youth across the country, Dr. Anderson founded a 501c3 non-profit organization that works to cultivate healthy academic and racial identities within the youth. Dr. Anderson is a first-generation college graduate, as well as the first African American male to be admitted into the Ph.D. program of Community Resources and Development at Arizona State University, and subsequently the first African American male to complete the program. Dr. Anderson is a fervent advocate for education, as he believes it to be the panacea for many of the marginalized populations in our country.

Among all of his accomplishments, Dr. Anderson is a proud father of 5 amazing children (all from a previous marriage), and a 2022 Illinois State Champion as the Head Flag Football Coach of the East St. Louis District 189 Special Olympics Flag Football Team – **GO FLYERS!!**
